Why Participate in a Clinical Trial

By participating in a clinical trial, you are taking an active role in the development and approval new and potentially life-saving therapies.



THE SITE

Where trials are conducted: can be in various locations including hospitals. universities, clinics. or doctors' offices throughout the country

The Clinical Trial Team

THE SPONSOR

Trials are funded by pharmaceutical companies, medical centers, voluntary groups. or other organizations and/or individuals

WITHDRAWN Has stopped

early before enrolling its first participant

COMPLETED Has ended normally, and early but may participants

are no longer being examined or treated

SUSPENDED Has stopped

TERMINATED Has stopped early and will not start again

start again

ACTIVE, NOT RECRUITING Is ongoing, but

potential new participants are not currently being recruited or enrolled

ENROLLING BY

Is selecting its participants from a population, or group of people decided on by the researchers in advance

Different Study Recruitment Status

NOT YET RECRUITING

Has not started recruiting participants

RECRUITING

Is currently recruiting participants



THE PRINCIPAL **INVESTIGATOR (PI)**

Researcher or healthcare professional who leads the trial and heads the research team



THE STUDY COORDINATOR

Works closely with the principal investigator and oversees the research team and the participants throughout the trial

THE PARTICIPANT

Also known as a patient or a study subject, is anyone who provides consent to be in the trial. This could mean you or your loved one

THE ETHICS **REVIEW BOARD**

A group of individuals who reviews and monitors the trial to ensure that the volunteers who participate in the trial are protected and treated fairly
